For some time now, ADB has been posting the contents of Star Fleet Times onto the TFG web site. (Some confusion has resulted because there is no button that says "give me SFT34", but all of the parts of the recent SFTs are on the site. Joe Butler is currently revising the menu to make it easier to find each SFT as it is posted.) Obviously, if you have access to the Internet and do not have any need for a hard copy (or can print your own if you want one), there is no reason for you to renew your subscription to SFT. It would be a good bet that the paid circulation of SFT will decline steadily as subscriptions expire and people go get their own copies from the web. However, ADB is committed to providing hard copies of SFT to anyone who wants to maintain a paid subscription, even if that is just two or three people. (It is known that military personnel overseas prefer the hard copies.)
