

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#### (Z49.4) DESIGNER'S INFORMATION

This is a product currently in playtest. Most of what is in this product are the original designs created by Bruce Graw and Ken Burnside. The Nicozians are here, for now, to be playtested. This means that nothing in this product, short of the basic manner in which the rules of *Star Fleet Battles* operate, can be regarded as set in stone or warranted to work perfectly.

The Nicozians are the merging of two species proposals by Bruce Graw and Ken Burnside; Bruce proposed a Kzinti simulator empire using a new movement system, and Ken proposed a species of creatures native to the crust of a neutron star using collapsed matter for armor and micro black holes as mines.

Neither proposal, in the opinions of the respective authors, had enough pizzazz to make them worth submitting to ADB. Each proposal added something that the other lacked. After a brief discussion, Ken Burnside took over the integration of the two proposals into one whole.

During the integration process, various components amalgamated at different times, and in many ways, the design process was one of "testing the envelope" of SFB. It was the express intention of both designers (the then Orion and Andromedan commanders on the Staff) to create something truly different for SFB.

The Nicozians are not, and never will be, a "campaign capable" empire, as evidenced by their lack of generic units, bases and combat variants, such as minesweepers and tugs. They can best be thought of as something in the gray area between monsters and "apolitical" empires, such as the Jindarians and Orions. Nicozian background by Ken Burnside.
